Board the coach bus at the Carpenter Museum and ride around Rehoboth with tour-guided stops at some of our more fascinating former one-room schoolhouses.

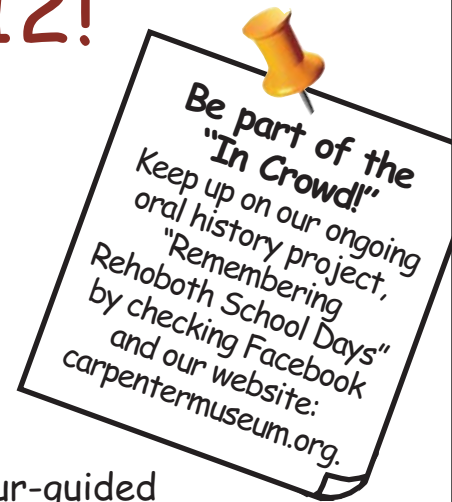
3. "Teachers Talk" Forum at Goff Hall (Blanding Library), Sunday, May 6, 1-3pm
